

ausDANCE ACT

COVID Safe Plan for in-school Dance and Film Tutor visits as per the updated Education Directorate where:

- tutors are permitted on site with any additional risk mitigation measures in place where required.
- Students from individual classes or cohort groups can participate in a dance class indoors.

1	When attending a school for a tutoring session, Ausdance dance and film tutors will comply with the COVID policies of the school once they are on campus.
2	Tutors will not visit the campus if they are unwell and will inform Ausdance ACT who will communicate with the teacher.
3	Visitors to campus will check in to the school at the front office through the CBR check in app.
4	Tutors will be required to wear a mask in all indoor areas, but may remove while undertaking vigorous activity with the cohort. To note: masks may be removed when performing tasks where wearing a mask may present a health and safety risk, however must be put back on when the tasks are completed.
5	Tutors will carry hand sanitizer, also encourage students to use after their dance session.
6	Tutors will encourage physical distancing when students are not dancing.
7	Encourage self and student use of tissues and covering mouth when coughing or sneezing.
8	Ausdance ACT will keep a record of dates and times of all school visited by the tutors.
